Physically large and ebulliently energetic, the works treat questions of the place and function of nature in the human imagination handled with a surety of execution and mature philosophical perspective. Contemplative in emotional depth and absorbing in explanatory observation, these black and white ink and graphite drawings express in generous detail, East and West and the timeless issues of civilized existence. As always, Hammerlein exercises an insouciant sense of humor, invigorating his psychologically dense compositions.

Chris Hammerlein's work has appeared in numerous exhibitions throughout the United States, Europe, and Mexico. This will be his third solo exhibition with the gallery.
